About the University-

Chaudhary Charan Singh University (formerly, Meerut University) was established in 1965, to cater to the needs of higher education in western Uttar Pradesh. The University celebrated its silver jubilee in 1991. Presently, it is one of the premier educational institutions of the country encompassing a vast, beautiful and pollution-free campus which sprawls over 222 acres of land having vast playgrounds and experimental fields, botanical garden, rose garden with life-size statue of the late Prime Minister Ch. Charan Singh, Gymnasium, Indoor Stadium, well equipped Library, Hostels for both girls and boys, Administrative Block, Spacious Auditorium, Guest House, Community Center, Medical Center, Residential Quarters for faculty members and employees, Canteen, Bank and Post office. The teaching department belonging to different faculties, are housed in spacious buildings and have well-equipped laboratories and advanced facilities. The University also has a separate engineering college, which is currently offering courses leading to B.Tech. degree in several different branches of engineering.

Initially, the M.Phil and Ph.D. programmes were started in 1969 taking credit of becoming first University in the country to introduce M.Phil. programme. In 1973, Post Graduate level courses were also introduced with the modernized syllabi. Since then, the University has been progressing at a steady rate. During the VIII five years plan, introduction of self-financed courses keeping in pace with the changing demands of the society and also for human resources development, were planned. Now, there are five faculties with 22 UGC sponsored and 35 self-financed/job oriented courses being run in the campus. 252 professional colleges/institutions 109 colleges and one constituent college are affiliated to Chaudhary Charan Singh University.

Under the able leadership of the Vice Chancellor, a renowned innovative technologist and an established committed academic administrator, the university is offering a large number of new and innovative post-graduate, under-graduate, diploma, advanced diploma and postgraduate diploma courses under self-financed scheme in areas of Agricultural Sciences, Humanities, Social Sciences, Journalism, Mass Communication and Multimedia Techniques, Earth Sciences, Teacher and Physical Education, Fine Arts, Legal Studies, Applied Sciences, Home Science, Business Studies, Geographical Information System (GIS) and Remote Sensing.

A distinct feature of the academic program is the semester system and continuous evolution of the students through quizzes, tests and seminars. The academic program exposes the students to practical aspects through computer labs, seminars, group discussions and lectures of experts invited from other institutions. The recognition of the university is due to the efforts of well-qualified and committed faculty members who have been providing quality education to postgraduate, M.Phil. and Ph.D. students. The University has also made a mark in the field of sports, and our students are second to none in their achievements.

The University has always been proud of its alumni who are occupying high positions of great responsibilities and distinction in educational and research institutions in India and abroad as well as administrative positions in the industries, defense and civil services. The success of the students of the university in NET, GATE, ARS, GRE and other examinations such as civil and administrative services etc. speak of the standard and quality of education provided by the university. The research activities in the various departments of the university are supported by grants in the form of research projects sanctioned by UGC, DBT, DST, ICAR, AICTE, UPSTC, CSIR and other funding agencies of the central and state governments.

About the Department:

The department of Economics was established in 1977 with the objective of promoting post-graduate studies and research in Economics with a special thrust on emerging areas in theoretical and applied Economics. The Department of Economics with its team of well-qualified and experienced teachers provides thorough and in-depth training in theoretical and applied Economics through its various courses. The main objective of the department is to develop skilled manpower capable of analyzing economic problems at different levels of sophistication

and suggesting solutions in terms of the policy. The students of the department have been well received in the job market and their performance in terms of success rate at different national examinations has always been above average. It is reflected through their placement in various organizations which include academic and research institutions at the highest level, Civil Services, Commercial Banks, the Reserve Bank of India, Private Corporate Business Houses, etc. In addition, the commercial and manufacturing enterprises, both the public and private sectors, absorb a bulk of the manpower trained in Economics.

The significance of Economics as a discipline of study has greatly increased since it was realised that economic elements are essential to a society's or an individual's development. The need for professionally qualified economists is growing, and as a result, trained students are a natural consequence of this development. The department has been coordinating M.A., M.Phil., and Ph.D. programme in a wide range of economic issues. In the form of the M.Phil. programme, it was one of the first research institutions to develop a quality improvement programme for research between the M.A. and Ph.D. degrees. However, the M.Phil. programme had discontinued from the academic year 2019-20, and the department introduced a new bachelor level programme of B.A. (Honours) in Economics in self-finance mode in the academic year 2019-20 and Pre-Ph.D. course from 2019.

In order to keep up with the times, the Board of Studies regularly updated the syllabi of these programmes. The Department has well-furnished classrooms. The department also has a computer lab to train students to statistical and econometric software as well as various databases of the Indian Economy, Census, NSO, Demographic and Health Survey, and other Socio-Economic Surveys. The Department's library houses a vast collection of quality books. The department fosters a well-rounded academic environment and ensures that visiting-faculties contribute frequently. The department is currently a hive of research activities, with research being conducted in a wide range of issues of Indian Economy and top-notch doctoral and post-graduate programmes. Public Finance, Agriculture Economics, Industrial Economics, Demography, Health Economics, Environmental Economics, and contemporary issues of Indian Economy are all well covered by the department's research programmes. The University, UGC, ICSSR, the Government of Uttar Pradesh, and other organisations have financially supported various research projects the department has taken-up.

About the Capacity Building Programme:

Capacity building and personality development have become key requirement for survival in today's global environment, particularly in academia, where advancements have become more dynamic than previously. In the social sciences, research has become so important to faculty members that professional progress without it is nearly impossible. The inclusion of this feature in the new national education policy, 2020, has increased the value of social science research. Given the importance of capacity building programmes in academics, it has become necessary to use this as an opportunity to strengthen our affirmative action policies in higher education by organising such training with a priority for young faculty (regular/ad-hoc/contractual). In light of the recent pandemic situation, this training programme will be conducted in offline format, which will provide a conducive safe environment for participants and resource persons to participate in this academic exercise with safety measures during workshop.

Objectives

The purpose of this Capacity Building Programme is to develop our academics by building the capacity of young faculty members. With only twelve working days, the planned capacity-building programme is designed to direct faculty members toward certain goals:

- 1) To improve research skills through erudite lectures on social research topics.
- 2) To provide knowledge on how to write a research proposal for a project.
- 3) To gain a better understanding of how to do qualitative research.
- 4) To provide learners with understanding about how to conduct social research.
- 5) To teach writing skills with a concentration on reputed/peer-reviewed journals.

Themes for the capacity building program:

The suggested capacity-building programme would be focused on the following main themes in order to attain the above-mentioned objectives:

- a) Research Technique, focusing on social research methodology
- b) Developing research instruments and determining the best strategy for conducting qualitative research.
- c) Working with quantitative data or doing quantitative social research using the statistical tools.
- d) Writing research proposals in order to obtain minor/major projects from various funding bodies interested in social research promotion.

Guidelines of the Programme:

Mode of Programme: The programme is proposed to be conducted in offline mode at Chaudhary Charan Singh University Meerut only.

Eligibility for the Programme:

Applications are invited from in service teachers engaged at UGC recognized universities/ colleges.

Programme Fees:

There is NO FEE as this is entirely an ICSSR funded Programme.

Number of Seats:

There are 30 seats out of which 10 are reserved for outside State participants, 10 within State participants and 10 for Local participants.

Attendance, Assessment, and Participation Certificate:

This programme will have 36 sessions during 12 days. Attending all 36 sessions is mandatory for participants failing which they shall be automatically disqualified from receiving Participation Certificate. The learning's of the participants shall be evaluated using daily quizzes, and, presentation of their research assignment. On the aforesaid basis they shall be awarded A, B, C & D grades, Participants after successful completion of the Programme (Securing at least C grade in evaluation) shall be provided with participation certificate mentioning their grades.

Travel and Accommodation of Participants attending programme in person:

Outstation participants will be reimbursed for their travel costs as per CCS University rules & regulations. Accommodation to outstation participants will be provided on a twin-sharing basis at the CCS University Guest House/ Nearby Hotels. Vegetarian Food arrangements shall be made for all the participants.
