(i) Indo-Korea International Workshop/ Technical Virtual Training on Nanoparticle- Based Plasma Bioscience, May 04-05, 2022 Department of Physics organized an International workshop under the supervision of Prof. Beer Pal Singh entitled “Indo-Korea International Workshop/ Technical Virtual Training on Nanoparticle-based Plasma Bioscience, May 4-5, 2022”.

This international workshop was jointly organized by the CCS University and Kwangwoon University-Seoul, South Korea in the Virtual mode. This workshop was organized on 04-05 May 2022 under the MoU established in 2020 between CCS University and Kwangwoon University, South Korea. There were more than 800 participants from all states and the premier institutes/universities in India and abroad also. The faculties and Scholars participated actively for both workshop sessions including the Plenary talk (first session) and Virtual hands-on-practice (Second Session). The researchers (State/ Central University) from every state of India along with more than 20 countries of the world such as Argentina, Taiwan, Korea, Egypt, Sri Lanka, Saudi Arabia, Myanmar, Pakistan, Ghana participated. Almost 800 participants participated in this virtual workshop.

The detailed outline and the objective of this workshop was explained by Prof. Sanjeev Kumar Sharma and all participants of the workshop were welcomed by the HOD. Convener of the workshop Prof. Beer Pal Singh. The Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Sangeeta Shukla, Chief Guest Prof. Eun Ha Choi, Korea, Pro-VC Prof. Y. Vimala, Dean of Science Prof. Mridul Kumar Gupta were honoured and welcomed for the same.

First lecture was delivered by Prof. Eun Ha Choi, Kwangwoon University, South Korea who

briefly explained about Kwangwoon University and about the research being done/continued in the Plasma Bioscience Research Centre. The second lecture was presented by Prof. Nagendra Kumar Kaushik, Kwangwoon University, South Korea. In the second session of First day of the workshop, the technical virtual training was organised through an online medium. Prof. Kaushik explained in detail about the hands - on - training for the methodology/operation of various types of research equipments available in the Plasma Bio Science Research Lab, Kwangwoon University.

The participants learned in detail about the plasma based instruments, optical sensing, Raman spectroscopy, plasma sterilizer, AFM, EDAX and contact angle measurement, FTIR techniques. The research scholars demonstrated



the actual use of micro-Raman spectrometer and Atomic Force Microscopy for Bio- sensors. At the end of the program, a brief description and a vote of thanks was given by Prof. Sanjeev Kumar Sharma. The organising committee delivered a vote of thanks to the eminent professors and dignitaries like Prof. Anil K. Malik, Prof. Anuj Kumar, Dr. Y.K. Gautam, Dr. Anil Yadav, Prof. Jaimala, Prof. Ramakant, Prof. C.P. Singh. On the second day of the workshop, Prof. Ashish explained about his research work in the field of Nanoparticle-based cancer treatment which was

followed by Dr. Anil K. Yadav lecture who explained about the crystal growth.

Prof. Sanjeev explained about the various microstructures of gold nanoparticles and zinc oxide for their use to detect and elimination of toxic ions/molecules for the development of Chemo-/Bio- sensors, which is very useful in daily life.

The Second session of the workshop was chaired by Prof. Anuj Kumar. The first virtual training was headed by Dr. Y.K. Gautam, and his team (Manohar, Shreshta, Akansha, Durgesh) while the second virtual training was headed by Prof. Sanjeev Sharma and his team (Abhishek Sharma, Anirudh Kumar, Vinod Kumar Pal, Km. Preeti). A special vote of thanks was given by Prof. Sanjeev Kumar Sharma who concluded the entire two-days workshop.

## National Seminar on Optimization: Fuzzy Logic and MATLAB

**N**ational Seminar on “Optimization : Fuzzy Logic and MATLAB”, sponsored by U. P. Govt. was organized by Department of Mathematic from 25th-26th March 2022.

Prof. S. R. Singh, Chair Person of the National Seminar introduced the whole team of the Seminar and also informed about the theme “Optimization: Fuzzy Logic and MATLAB”. Eight guests delivered their lectures on various topics related to the theme of Seminar and almost 123 research scholars participated from different colleges. 80 research scholars presented their research papers related to the theme of seminar. On the first day, a three lecture session and two technical session and on second day a five lecture session and two technical sessions were conducted. The first day of the programme commenced with a lecture by Professor Debjani Chakraborty (IIT Kharagpur) on Fuzzy Optimization. The last lecture of the session was delivered by Dr. Pitam Singh (MNNIT Prayagraj) on “Fuzzy AHP”. On second day, the first lecture was delivered by Dr. Ashok Kumar(HNB Garhwal University Srinagar) on MATLAB and its Applications. The availability of MATLAB in many operating system such as Windows, Macintosh, Unix, Dos as well as the several tool boxes to solve specified problem were also discussed. A brief information about the display and formatting of MATLAB was also given along with various types of MATLAB file and generating vectors.

Prof. C.K. Jaggi discussed about the importance of sustainable supply chains and how it helps to improve productivity. By using sustainable technique, we can increase the efficiency of machinery and buildings with cost savings. Valuable information was shared about the Puma’s little clever bag and its benefits in reducing waste and CO2 emissions. Furthermore a discussion about the sustainable supply chain at Wal-Mart was also held. He discussed about the Wal-Mart’s goal which is to produce zero waste to be supplied with 100% renewable energy, to sell products that sustain people and the environment as well as the benefits of reverse supply chain

such as economic, ethical, environmental, etc. The third lecture of the second day was given by Retd. Professor C.B.Gupta (BITSPilani) on “Operation Research: An Overview ”. The Fourth lecture of the Second day was given by Dr.Arvind Yadav(Hansraj College, University of Delhi who discussed about MATLAB, high level programming language, interactive technical computing environment, Algorithm development, data analysis and visualization, numerical computation, faster than traditional computer language like as C, C++, and FORTRAN. He discussed about the MATLAB application domain such as numerical computation, signal and image processing, communication system and also about analyzing and accessing data as well as visualizing data.

The last lecture of the second day was delivered by Dr. H.N. Singh (R.S.S. P.G. College) on “Synchronous Optimization of Meyons”. This Seminar was very useful for all the participants. All the speakers were very learned and provided a lot of information related to modern day challenges. They were experts of their respective fields. The lectures were very informative, interactive and the participants learnt so much from this National Seminar.

On 26th March, the valedictory session was conducted by Dr Saru Kumari who invited Professor Shiv Raj Singh to say a few words about Seminar. Prof. Shiv Raj Singh appreciated of the entire team and congratulated the organizers for inviting various reputed resource persons for delivering relevant lectures in the Seminar. # MICROBIOLOGY

**A** workshop was held on 7th April 2022 on the following topic entitled: 'Detection of Adulteration in Common Food Items'. A total of 68 participants were enrolled for this workshop including both students and faculty members of affiliated colleges. Mr. Vaibhav Sharma, Food Safety Officer, delivered a lecture on "Swasth Aahar, Jeevan ka Aadhar". He discussed about the habit of checking the labels of packaged foods and aware the students to differentiate between healthy and unhealthy foods. Dr. Dinesh Panwar, delivered a lecture entitled "Impact of adulterated food on human health" and discussed various types of adulteration and how these adulterated food affected human body. Dr. Laxman Nagar delivered a lecture entitled "Detection of Adulteration in food items by household methods" and discussed the methods of detection of adulteration in various food items by household methods. Eighteen tests for detection of food adulteration was performed and taught to the participants during workshop.

**Health Checkup Camp:** A free health check up camp was organized. Drishti Eye Foundation checked eyes of 62 patients, Swami



Kalyan Dev Dispensary checked the blood pressure, weight, oxygen and pulse of 58 patients, Sparsh Pathology Lab, Dental and Skin Care Clinic checked the haemoglobin, Blood sugar and dental check up of 70 and 45 persons respectively.

**Recommendation/Outcome:** The workshop was organized to create awareness for the students so that they could learn some tests to detect the adulteration. The objective of the workshop was to give the participants an insight about the types of adulteration in common food items they consume in their daily lives and the participants were educated to detect these adulterated food.



Prof. Vikas Sharma, the eminent literary figure, has beautifully discussed in depth about the different types of Love in this novel. He has laid down clearly that even if a particular type of love is looked at as a taboo, it very much still exists. The aspect of the extra marital love affair has been presented to the readers through the female protagonist.

Prof. Sharma who is also a Love Poet says that love is love, what is the point of study in literature if one cannot be vocal and receptive towards all kinds of emotions that any individual feels. Hence, he has been very open and bold in discussing love that is in its very sense unique, forbidden and passionate. He has also talked about the issues of widow remarriage and has enlightened the readers that a widow has as much right to be in love as any other individual in this world. This novel has treated love with immense care and maturity and presented it as a powerful, overwhelming feeling that everyone has felt at some point in their life.

An important trait of love which has been emphasized in the novel as well as through the title is, love does not change or alter with time. This novel is proof of the same theory, the love that we see in this novel is unaffected by the effects of time, age, and other worldly factors. Love stands strong in face of whatever hurdles come in its way.

The story is told from the perspective of the female protagonist Richa, who is a reflection of contemporary upper-middle-class society. It lays bare the insecurities and fears of those people seemingly living happy and comfortable lives. The

novel is bold in its depiction of intimate scenes. It also deals with many other issues of social importance like the fate of children born out of wedlock, the fate of arranged marriages not faring well, social aspirations of persons with disabilities, the place of widows in society, the question of social acceptance of widow remarriage etc. Through the character of Richa, we come across




## IAS Today Fair is Foul and Foul is Fair: Treatment of Good & Bad

Don't be in hurry.



## WAR
