About the University

Chaudhary Charan Singh University, established in 1965 is one of the premier higher educational institution in western Uttar Pradesh It has a picturesque campus covering 222 acres of land. It also has the credit of being first university of the city to introduce M.Phil programme in1969. In 1973 Postgraduate level courses were also introduced. During the 8th Five Year Plan, self financed courses were also introduced Keeping in pace with the changing needs and aspirations of the modernised society and also bring in rapid human resource development There are nine faculties namely, Agriculture. Arts, Education, Science, Commerce & Management, Ayurveda, Engineering, Law and Medicine with 22 UGC and 35 self-financed courses providing a job oriented edge to the conventional education Presently, 20 Government, 50 grant- in-aid, 2 medical and 909 self financing professional colleges/ institutions and one constituent college is also affiliated to Chaudhary Charan Singh University. University also has a separate engineering college, offering courses in B.Tech in several branches of engineering. The university has all the contemporary, modern and technical facilities like playground and experimental fields, Botanical Garden, Gymnasium, Indoor Stadium, well equipped Library with modern internet connectivity, numerous hostels for boys and girls at all levels of higher education Administrative block, spacious Auditorium, Guest house, Community Center, Medical Center Residential quarters for faculty members and employees, Canteen, Bank and Post Office, spacious buildings with well equipped laboratories and advanced teaching aids, air conditioned Brashaspati Bhawan, Evaluation Centre Computer Centre, Wrestling Stadium and Athletic Tracks. The university offers a large number of innovative post graduate and diploma courses under self financed in the areas of GIS & Remote Sensing, T.V. Journalism, Human Rights, Social Work, Food Science & Technology, Plant Protection, Seed Science & Technology Bioinformatics, Nanotechnology, Food Nutrition, Ancient Indian History & Archaeology, Mass Media and Public Administration.

About the Department

The Department was established in 1977. Post Graduate teaching commenced in July 1978. Research component followed soon with the registration of M.Phil and Ph.D candidates in 1980. Apart from hundreds of Masters and M.Phil. students, approx. 250 candidates have successfully completed their Ph.D research, around 57 candidates have done PDF from the Department till date. The department also started Master of Public Administration (M.P.A) under self-financing scheme in 1994 and since then MPA programme is catering to the needs of aspirants of Indian administration. For almost five sessions, the department also ran the M.Phil programme in Public Administration. Currently in accordance to the National Education policy (NEP) 2020 the department runs undergraduate from a post graduate and doctoral programmes in political science/public administration. The department endeavours to bring in light the different relevant contemporary issues in political theory and thought, as well as to give the researchers a comprehensive knowledge of the subject in various dimensions of Indian political and philosophical domain. Of late, the department has initiated well-organized discourse on the nature and profile of ancient Indian political thinking by way of creating a fruitful dialogue among specialists and stakeholders as well as by providing platform for systematic research attempting to throw light on different dimensions of polity and statecraft ancient India. The Department has an illustrious academic staff profile since its establishment.Government of Uttar Pradesh has established Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Shodhpeeth (Research Chair) in the Department in January 2018, to initiate and strengthening the research on Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhayaya's philosophy. Further on 10 Feb 2019 Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India established Babu Jagjeevan Ram chair in the department .The department was associated with a Bi-annual journal 'The Meerut Journal of Political Science and Public Administration' during 1997-2008. The department has started publication of the 'Indian Journal of Political Science' since 2003 and 'Bhartiya Rajniti Vigyan Shodh Patrika' since 2009 through Indian Political Science Association in the Department of Political Science and still continuing to publish these reputed journals. Besides that the department is at present the headquarters of the Indian Political Science Association (IPSA) since August 2011.
